Scholarship Application Form

Purpose

The NZSAS Trust was established to help personnel who have actively served in or been posted to the New Zealand Special Air Service and their dependents.

The Vietnam Scholarship was specifically created to support beneficiaries doing comprehensive **tertiary** studies, and the Borneo Scholarship was created for those pursuing **trade** studies.

One new Vietnam Scholarship and one new Borneo Scholarship is awarded each year to worthy individuals to the amount of \$3,000 each. These individuals are then supported by the Trust for the next three years of tertiary studies, to a total of \$9,000 per scholarship. Please note that [any continuing support in years 2 and 3 is conditional on successful grades from the previous year.](#)

Who is Eligible?

Serving or retired personnel and the partners or children of a current or former member of 1 NZSAS Regiment, meaning a person who is:

- (a) Directly related to the current or former member, and
- (b) Wholly or in substantial part financially reliant on that member.

Supporting Documentation

Throughout the application you will be asked to provide documents which show evidence in support of

your application. Do not send original birth certificates or other original documents as they will not be returned. Please do not put your application into any sort of folder. Simply attach all pages with ONE staple in the top left hand corner. All pages should be A4 size.

Ensure you complete all relevant sections and have included:

- Copy of identification (license or passport)
- Evidence of current educational enrolment, education programme, or other supporting documentation for your application
- Copy of applicant's marriage certificate, birth certificate or signed evidence of a formal relationship (MD1123)

Privacy Policy

The information requested in this application form and your academic record and financial circumstance will be used for the purposes of assessing your application for the grant for which you are applying. Personal information contained in this application will be made available to trustees and their selection committee in assessing your application.

The NZSAS Trust undertakes to store your application in a secure place in the event that you are successful in gaining a grant, and to destroy your application to preserve its confidentiality in the event that you are unsuccessful in gaining a grant.

Should you have reason to believe that information held about you in either your application or your academic record is incorrect, you have the right of access to, and correction of, that information.

Applicants shall agree to the trustees obtaining their academic results from organisations such as NZQA, necessary to assess their application.

Applicant shall agree to co-operate with any publicity of the grant for which they have applied. Such publicity may include material provided with your application, photographs and interviews with grant recipients.

Payment of Grants

The grants will be paid after review and approval by the Trustees following receipt of a valid application, outlining how the Grant will be used.

The Trustees of the NZSAS Trust reserve the right to decline to offer some or any of the grants.
